



This diagram is gifted OPEN ACCESS (free to use and distribute without permission) to those students, professors and admin who want to understand the academic corruption within "accredited diploma mills" and their resultant trail of ruined careers, societal cynicism, cheated and indebted students, and betrayed customers (eg, patients in healthcare scenarios). Some colleges and universities demonstrate the full gamut of the characteristics represented, while others may have only a few components. An important concept to grasp from this illustration is that complex corruption occurs as an interconnected web, with many facets and participants; corruption is never an isolated event, especially when persistent. Furthermore, some aspects of academic corruption such as nepotism are simply the tip of the proverbial iceberg and are used to cover larger crimes such as theft. Administrators who don't like this diagram probably have a lot to hide, or they are the victims of this corrupt system.
